

Eco-Cultural Resilience and Traditional Knowledge: A Critical Analysis of China's Greenfield Investments

Nadire Burcu Gümüşfiliz

Abstract

This study explores how China's Greenfield investments influence eco-cultural resilience and the preservation of traditional ecological knowledge (TEK) in host countries. As Chinese capital expands through initiatives such as the Belt and Road Initiative, investment projects increasingly intersect with ecologically sensitive and culturally rooted communities. Employing a qualitative and interpretivist approach, the study analyses policy narratives, local case studies, and field-level evidence to assess whether sustainability discourses embedded in China's "green development" and "eco-civilization" frameworks align with local environmental and cultural realities.

Findings suggest that while Chinese investment rhetoric often emphasizes ecological responsibility, implementation frequently subordinates traditional knowledge systems and local governance practices. The study argues that sustainability requires integrating TEK as a core component of investment planning and environmental governance. It proposes *eco cultural resilience* as a conceptual framework that connects environmental integrity with cultural continuity, offering an alternative lens to evaluate the socio-ecological impacts of global capital flows.

By linking environmental justice, cultural sovereignty, and sustainability, this study contributes to rethinking how transnational investments can move beyond technocratic environmentalism toward more inclusive and co-evolutionary models of development.

Interpreting Framed Perceived Realities in English and Vietnamese Motion-Emotion Conceptual Metaphors

Abstract

This paper reports part of a study adopting a cross-cultural and cross-linguistic perspective in investigating how emotions are framed via motions in English and Vietnamese. The notion of frame and framing is primarily based on Entman (1993), Semino et al. (2018) and Sullivan's (2023) perspective in which a frame is conceptualized as consisting of symbolism, association, perception and projection of perceived realities. The focus on frame allows for revealing the nuances and hidden meanings within each metaphorical expression by scrutinizing the relationship between the various semantic elements of the emotion and motion domains, which earlier conceptual metaphor frameworks could not sufficiently explain. The study reveals that motion-emotion metaphors (MEMs) in English and Vietnamese bear several commonalities concerning how people of the two cultures associate the same features or attributes of one entity with another. The results also demonstrate that English and Vietnamese differ in framing MEMs by associating emotions with different aspects of perceived realities and bodily experiences. Individuals' cultural and linguistic experiences can shape how they conceptualise and express emotions. It is thus argued that while metaphor is a universal aspect of language used in various languages and cultures to express feelings, the specific ways emotions are conceptualised through motion can vary across languages and cultures.
