1. Conference Summary

1.1 Conference Overview

The 2nd International Multidisciplinary Conference on Medical & Health Sciences (IMCMH-2025) was successfully conducted on 18th and 19th December 2025 in Bangkok, Thailand, in both in-person and virtual formats.
