The theme highlights the importance of combining creativity, technological advancement, and business innovation to promote inclusive growth, sustainable development, and meaningful societal transformation.

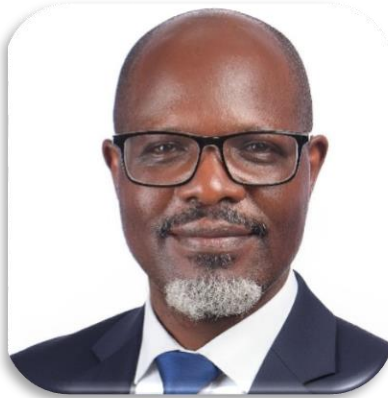
1.3 Objectives & Scope of the Conference

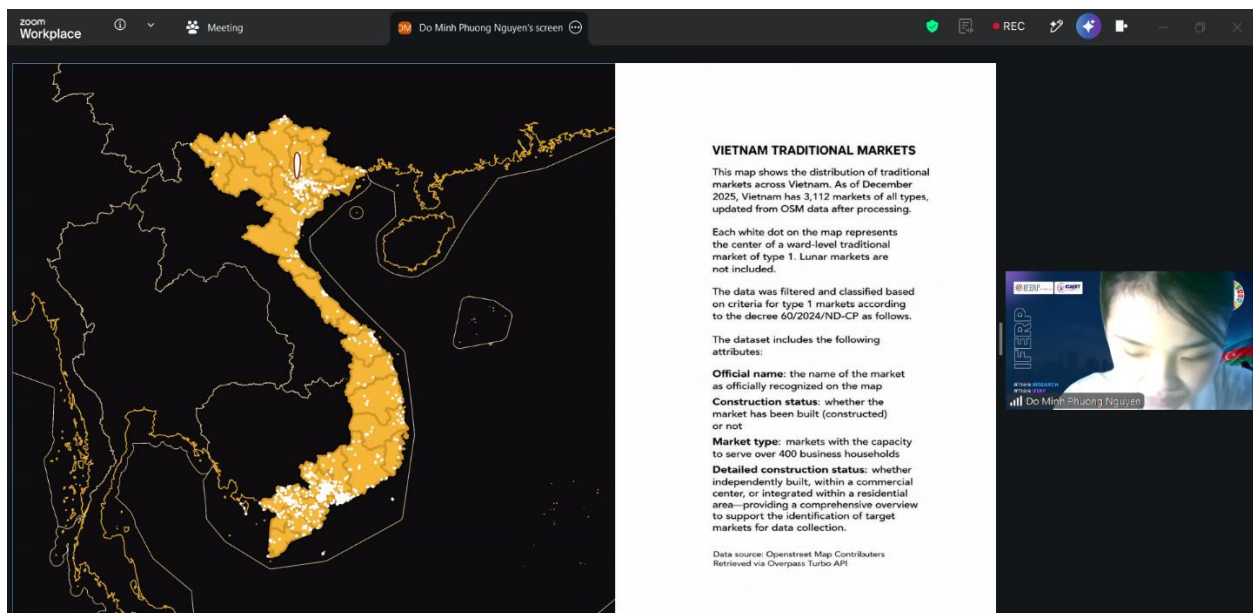
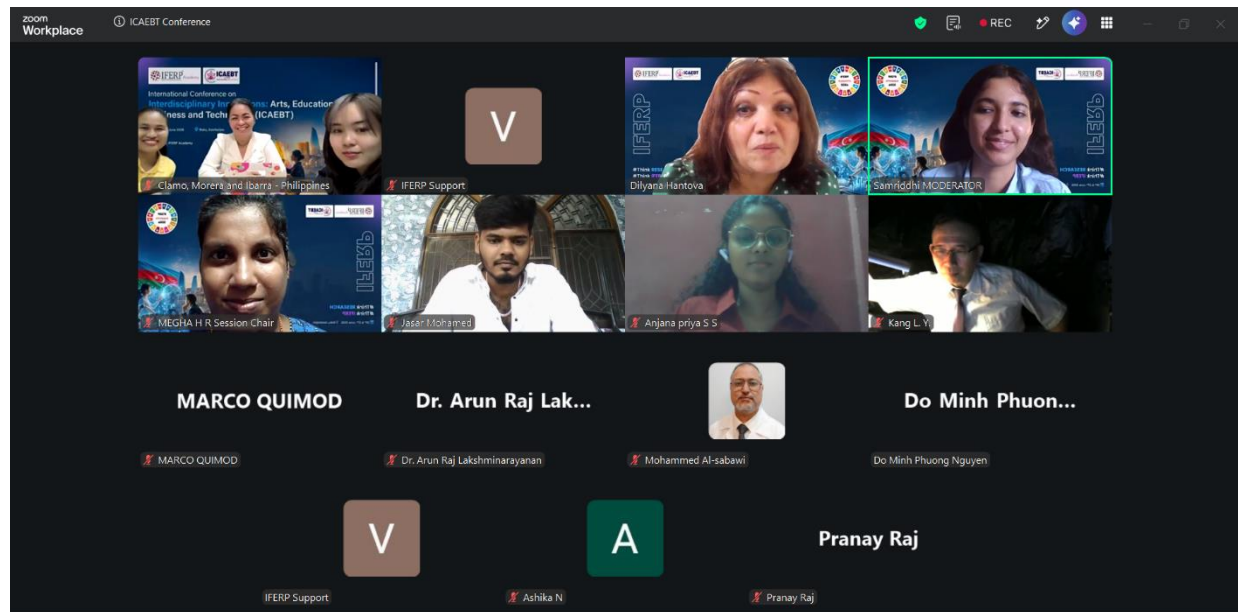

Silence as Spiritual Awakening

- In his posthumous work *Citadelle*, silence acquires a profoundly spiritual and metaphysical significance. The protagonist, the Citadel builder (Caid), who reigns “in the silence of my love” (“*dans le silence de mon amour*”), expresses the desire to write a hymn to silence (“*J’écirai un hymne au silence*”). In this context, silence is closely associated with love, meditation, and the revelation of the divine through prayer.
- Saint-Exupéry writes:
- “And that the learning of prayer and the learning of silence [...] Love first is the practice of prayer, and prayer is the practice of silence.”

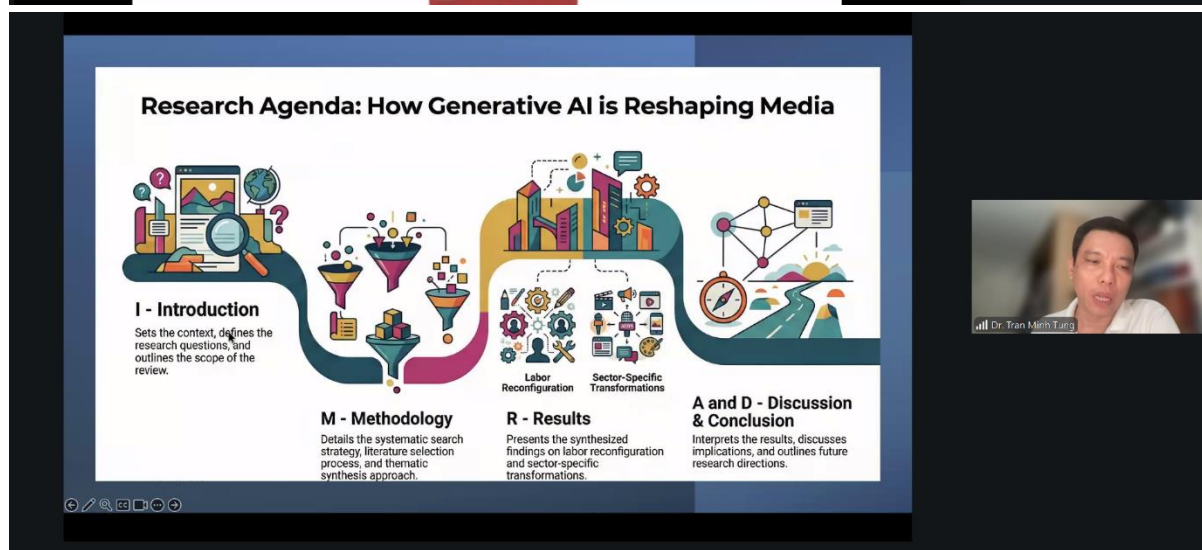
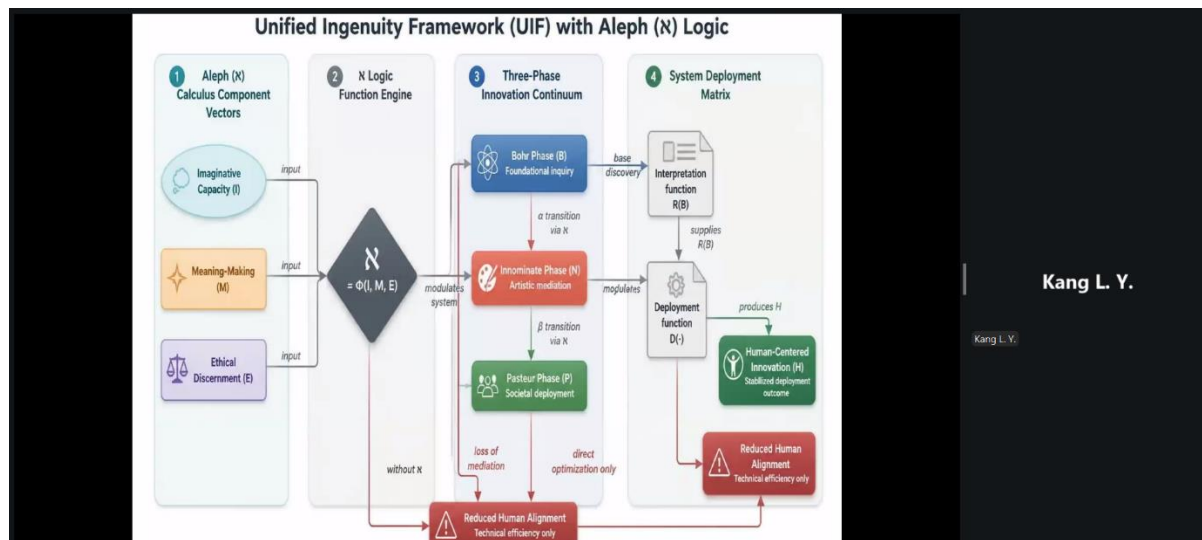
